On the “Fourth Watch of the Night” at Momma’s house in her kitchen at 3:20am a strong urging of Holy Spirit permeated my heart on October 3rd just a few days ago!***

***This Prayer Vision is based on a short Biblical foundation-“God responds to concerts of Prayer—as preparation for Revival and Reconstruction! “For example in the book of Nehemiah the people Prayed for FOUR months and it took TWO months to do the work”! Also, when you read the first two chapters of Acts Jesus said, “Go to Jerusalem” in the Upper Room, to wait and Pray! This period of time was for “Fifty Days” and the result was coming of Holy Spirit to birth the church. Remember “The Church” not Holy Spirit had her birthday on Pentecost(50 days)!***

***What is the point of all of this Pastor Frankie? I am so glad you asked! The writing of this article is October 11th and it is the “Fourth Watch of the Night”- 4:30am! Today starts a “Sixty day concert of Prayer” with our brothers and sisters in Central America! Our time frame is until December 11th. This will be a “Pentecost Peluso” strategy for myself, hopefully on December 20th!***

***The reason for sharing this is to ask you to join with us –several hundred pastors, churches and families for a “Fresh Encounter with Holy Spirit”!***

***Please consider a beginning strategy of Praying in four areas— 1) Preparation of our hearts 2) Protection from the evil one 3) Provisions from God’s hands and 4) Production of Fruit of Holy Spirit (Kingdom Work)! Some of the pastors in Nicaragua have already starting to Pray. At the present time Holy Spirit is our Guide— How to Pray!! Join us in this “Sixty Day Concert of Prayer” for a great work of God to take place in Central America. I believe God works more in our lives when we Pray for others (Boomerang Effect)!***
