Encouragement In These Last Days

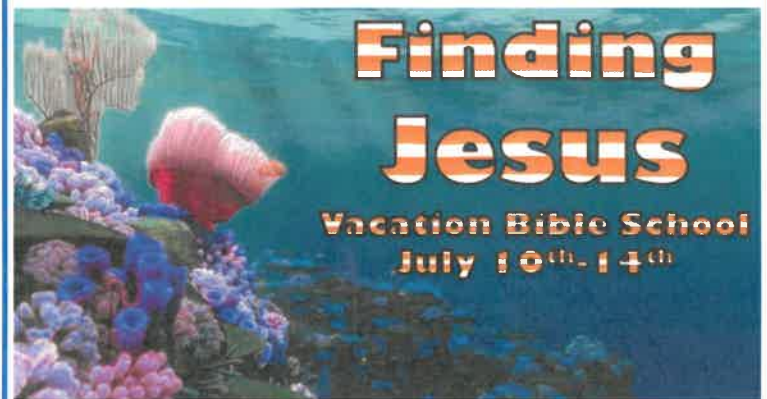
HELL

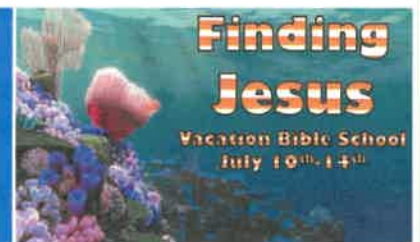
